You have all that is needed to assure yourself a great Northern Canada fishing experience.

The fishing season begins in June and lasts all the way until mid October. Each portion of the season offers different options depending upon your wants and needs. Remember! The expert guides at Kenanow are present to assist and help you achieve your dream. If you are a novice, not a problem! If you are an expert they will help perfect your skills. We have chosen the 3rd week in September for one big reason. LAKE TROUT IN THE SHALLOWS! Last year as our trip ended in early September we noticed that the trout became very aggressive as the water grew cooler. Adding two more weeks for our return should make the lake trout, large pike and walleye fishing something to behold.

Kenanow Lodge is family owned and has been in the Matheson family since 1991. Prepare to be pampered! Delicious meals, great hospitality and top notch service is what Kenanow Lodge is all about. The VIP cabin where we will stay on our group trip can sleep 10 very comfortably. This VIP cabin has with 3 bedrooms and two loft areas to assure your comfort. If you are not with one of our groups the lodge can also accommodate your needs with other options suited for smaller groups of two or more. Remember! We are going this year with one thing in mind. BIG FISH IN THE SHALLOWS! September begins the migration of the big lake trout (40lbs +) to the shallow water. At this time of year cast conventionally, with a fly rod, or troll for them. The pike are also very active as these fish are beginning to sense that winter is coming and gorge themselves before the snow begins to fly in November. Walleye are always around and are there for the taking. (see photos below)
